



REVA MEDICAL, INC. AUSTRALIAN PRIVACY POLICY

Policy Statement

REVA Medical, Inc. ("**REVA**," the "**Company**," "**us**," or "**we**") (ARBN 146 505 777) collects, uses, holds, shares and discloses your personal information (which includes any information or opinion, about an identified individual or an individual who can be reasonably identified from their information) in/from Australia ("**Personal Information**") in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

REVA may collect Personal Information about:

- Individuals, including Personal Information about individuals within businesses
- Securityholders
- Other people who come into contact with the Company in the ordinary course of business

Personal Information is collected by us for the reasons set out in this Privacy Policy and also to facilitate the effective provision of a service or inquiry, to manage our relationship with an individual, to comply with laws, and/or to operate our business (including by using Personal Information to improve our services). Personal Information is used in accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the data protections laws of the jurisdictions in which we operate.

In certain circumstances, failure to provide Personal Information to us may prevent us from providing you with the information or services you require and/or may prevent us from doing business with you.

Personal Information

Why do we collect Personal Information?

In addition to the purposes for which we collect Personal Information as referred to above, we also collect Personal Information for a number of specific purposes as set out below.

As a listed entity on the Australian Securities Exchange ("**ASX**"), we may have certain obligations imposed on us under the Corporations Act, regulatory instruments and regulator directions. We may collect, use and disclose Personal Information in order to be able to effectively discharge these obligations.

We collect Personal Information about our securityholders ("**Securityholders**") in order for us to perform our functions and obligations as a listed company and to provide Securityholders with relevant information and services.

We collect Personal Information about our Australian non-executive directors and any Australian employees or consultants for the purposes of arranging, facilitating, and administering our compensation and benefit plans, including our Amended and Restated 2010 Equity Incentive Plan (as

this may be amended or replaced), and for compliance reporting relating to such plans and the participation of individuals in them. In addition, we collect Personal Information about contractors, consultants, and suppliers in order to manage and facilitate our business with these individuals.

We also collect Personal Information from Australian individuals and companies in order to respond to emails, answer questions or resolve problems.

What other specific types of Personal Information do we collect?

If you are a Securityholder, we may collect Personal Information including your name, address, contact details, title, and the number of our securities owned by you in order for us to respond to inquiries, resolve problems, and administer matters related to our issued securities. Our CDI registry, currently Computershare Investor Services Pty Limited, administers the records and transactions related to holdings in REVA's CHESS Depository Interests ("**CDIs**") and any other securities we have issued in Australia, and we may disclose information to Computershare (or any replacement CDI registry) for such purposes. Computershare has established and published privacy policies that detail their safeguarding and use of Personal Information.

If you are an Australian director, employee, or consultant, we may collect the following Personal Information to manage and facilitate your participation in our compensation and benefit plans or other business you may have with REVA:

- Name and date of birth
- Tax file number or other identification number
- Job title and compensation
- Country or state of residency
- Address and telephone number
- Securities owned as well as entitlements to securities

If you are an Australian contractor, service provider, supplier or job applicant we may collect Personal Information such as your name, contact details, and other information we require to do business with you, or to consider your application including, but not limited to, education, professional qualifications, age, prior employment, registrations, and tax file number or other taxpayer identification number. We may also collect background information containing criminal offenses or credit ratings, if we've received authorization in writing by you to collect such information.

How do we collect Personal Information?

Personal Information is collected in a variety of ways, including by way of personal contact, as well as mail, telephone, email, and the internet.

If you are a Securityholder we will collect your Personal Information from you directly, through our share registry, or through information provided to us by you via our website.

If you are an Australian director, employee, or consultant, we will collect information from you directly.

If you are a contractor, service provider, supplier, or job applicant, we will ordinarily collect Personal Information directly from you. However, in some circumstances, we may conduct searches of publically available information and/or conduct background checks.

How do we use and disclose Personal Information?

If you are a Securityholder we use your Personal Information as is reasonably necessary to provide services or manage our relationship with you, for example to enable the resolution of a concern or complaint.

If you are an Australian director, employee or consultant, we may use your Personal Information to facilitate and manage your participation in our compensation and benefit plans and as otherwise required for compliance reporting.

If you are an Australian contractor, service provider, supplier, or job applicant we may disclose your Personal Information where there is a requirement to give effect to an element of our business relationship with you including for reference and background checks.

In addition to the circumstances in which we disclose Securityholders' Personal Information to our current CDI registry as described above, we may also disclose your Personal Information to third-party service providers we use in to support our business; for example logistics companies, cloud storage providers, IT service providers, etc. We endeavor to ensure that such third-parties are required to comply with our data protection policies and applicable law.

Where the GDPR applies to your Personal Information, we comply with our obligations under the GDPR by: (1) keeping Personal Information up to date; (2) storing it securely; (2) not collecting or retaining excessive amounts of Personal Information; (3) protecting Personal Information from loss, misuse, unauthorized access and disclosure; and (4) ensuring that appropriate technical measures are in place to protect Personal Information. We process Personal Information only where: (1) the data subject provides consent; (2) processing is necessary in performance of a contractual or other legal obligation; (3) processing is necessary to protect vital interests of the data subject or another person; (4) processing is in the public interest; or (5) processing serves our legitimate interests.

We may also be legally required to disclose your Personal Information in response to requests from regulators and law enforcement or security agencies.

Cross-border disclosure of Personal Information

We store your Personal Information on IT systems that are or may be located in jurisdictions other than in Australia, including the United States and Europe. We may disclose Personal Information to, or permit access to Personal Information from, any offices of our company and our affiliates, and/or third party service providers referred to in this Privacy Policy, which offices may be located in the United States, Europe or other countries. We take appropriate steps to ensure that Personal Information is processed, secured, and transferred according to applicable law.

We transfer Personal Information to, or permit access to Personal Information from, countries outside the European Economic Area (EEA). We will, in all circumstances, safeguard Personal Information as set out in this Privacy Policy.

Personal Information collected through our website www.revamedical.com

When you visit our website you are not required to disclose any information about yourself. If you contact us through the gateway on our website and choose to provide Personal Information, we will utilize such data to respond to your inquiry. We do not collect or maintain personally identifiable information for resale purposes, or share your information with any other company or organization.

Our website may contain links to other websites. We do not share your Personal Information with those websites and we are not responsible for their privacy practices.

Unsecured Email Warning

Any information that you send to us in an email is considered unsecure. Due to the nature of the internet, there is a possibility that unsecured (i.e., unencrypted) email could be intercepted and read by third parties. We assume no responsibility for interception of confidential information (including a resume or other document containing Personal Information) that you send in an unsecured email message.

Do not send information related to medical conditions or other specific personal health items via email. We cannot be responsible for personal health information sent through email.

Anonymous data collected through our website www.revamedical.com

In addition to the information you provide when you use our website, we collect anonymous information about the use of our website. For example, our website tracks how many visitors access our website, the date and time of their visit, the length of their stay, and which pages they view. It also tracks which Web browsers our visitors use and the address from which they accessed our site. This technology does not identify you personally. Currently, we do not analyze these statistics for any purpose.

Storage and security of your Personal Information

The security of your Personal Information is important to us and we take reasonable steps to protect the Personal Information we hold about you from misuse, loss, unauthorized access, modification, or disclosure. These measures include computer safeguards, access restrictions, and secured files and buildings.

However, data protection and security measures are never completely secure and, despite the measures we have put in place, we cannot guarantee the complete security of your Personal Information. You must take care to protect your Personal Information and you should also notify us as soon as possible if you become aware of any security breaches.

We take reasonable steps to destroy or permanently de-identify any Personal Information after it can no longer be used.

How can you access or seek correction of the Personal Information we hold about you?

We will take reasonable steps to ensure that Personal Information held about you is accurate, complete, and up-to-date. If you wish to know what Personal Information we hold about you or would like to request a correction to the Personal Information that we hold about you, please contact us (see contact details below).

In order for us to respond to your request, you will need to provide us with information to verify your identity, which may include your full name, contact details, Securityholder identification, or other relevant information. You will need to provide a description of the information you wish to access and/or specify the manner in which the information we hold is inaccurate, out of date, irrelevant, incomplete, or misleading and how it should be amended.

Specific GDPR rights

If the GDPR applies to you and the Personal Information we have collected, you have certain rights as described below. If you wish to exercise one these rights, please contact our Data Protection Administrator at dataprotection@revamedical.com. To ensure an efficient follow-up, we kindly ask you to clearly specify your request and to indicate to which aspect or element of Personal Information your request relates.

You have the following rights (please be aware that certain exceptions apply to the exercise of these rights and so you may not be able to exercise these in all situations):

- **Right of access:** you have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not Personal Information concerning you is being processed, and, where that is the case, to obtain a copy of the Personal Information we maintain about you.
- **Correction:** you may ask us to correct any inaccurate Personal Information that we process.
- **Erasure:** you may ask us to delete Personal Information that we no longer have a legal ground to process.
- **Restriction:** you may ask us to mark certain Personal Information as restricted whilst complaints are resolved and also ask for restriction of processing under certain other circumstances.
- **Portability:** you can ask us to transmit the Personal Information that you have provided to us and we still hold about you to a third party electronically.

In addition, under certain conditions, you have the right to:

- where processing is based on consent, withdraw the consent;
- object to any processing of Personal Information that we justify on the “legitimate interests” legal ground, unless our reasons for undertaking that processing outweigh any prejudice to your privacy rights; and
- object to direct marketing at any time.

These rights are subject to certain exemptions to safeguard the public interest (e.g. the prevention or detection of crime) and our interests (e.g. the maintenance of legal privilege). We will respond to most requests within 45 days.

How will we deal with complaints about how we handle your Personal Information?

Please contact us if you are not happy with how we have handled your Personal Information or if you are concerned that we have breached an obligation under the Australian Privacy Principles or this Privacy Policy (see contact details below).

We will consider your complaint and determine whether it requires further investigation. We will notify you of the outcome of this determination and/or any subsequent internal investigation.

If you are not satisfied with our response, you may wish to contact the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner at www.oaic.gov.au.

If the GDPR applies to your Personal Information, you also have the right to contact the applicable National Data Protection Authority, whose contact information can be found here: http://ec.europa.eu/justice/data-protection/bodies/authorities/index_en.htm.
